From the Office of Civil Rights: “In classifying the allegations, look to the likely motives of the alleged harasser, and not the actual status of the alleged victim.”

Harassment or bullying on the basis of sex includes, sexual harassment or bullying and gender-based harassment or bullying:

- Sexual harassment or bullying is unwelcome conduct of a sexual nature, such as unwelcomed sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal, non-verbal, or physical conduct of a sexual nature.
- Gender-based harassment or bullying is nonsexual intimidation or abusive behavior toward a student, based on the student’s actual or perceived sex, including harassment based on gender identity, gender expression, and nonconformity with gender stereotypes.
