# Stay at Home Checklist



## See You in Class!

- Have a **runny nose** or a little cough, but **no other symptoms**
- No fever-reducing medicine for 24 hours**, and no fever during that time (temp. of 100.4 F/38 C or higher)
- No throwing up or diarrhea for 24 hours



## Best to Stay Home.

- Temperature higher than 100.4 F (with or without medicine)
- Persistent cough
- Throwing up or diarrhea
- Eyes are pink and crusty
- Instructed by a doctor to isolate from others



## Heading to school! What should I know?

We're so glad you're coming! A day of missed school is a lost opportunity for social development. By **coming** to school **every day your student is not sick**, they are gaining social skills to help them land their first job as an adult!



## At school your student learns:

- Time management
- Problem Solving
- Collaboration
